

Rules and instructions for the use of Växjö Municipality's network

All users of Växjö Municipality's network must use the school's IT equipment in a responsible manner, regardless of whether one is using a personal computer or not. Sweden's currently-valid legislation and the values of the curriculum serve as the norms. This means that everyone should respect the equal worth of all people, use correct language, and protect both their own integrity and that of others. Personal attacks are never allowed.

Computers on the network must never be used in a way that conflicts with legislation currently in force, e.g. to download copyrighted material, or inappropriate or illegal material.

1. The school's computers and network are primarily for schoolwork. All users on the school network must behave responsibly and be careful with the equipment.
2. It is not permitted to use anyone else's account or password – you may only use your own account. You may not tell anyone else your password. Always log out when you are finished working.
3. Sweden's legislation applies on the internet as well. It is not permitted to bully, harass or insult other people in any way in chats, e-mail or forums. You should use correct language when communicating.
4. Programs, images and music on the internet may not be used in any manner. You may not download or install games, programs or files that you do not have the rights to. There can be no pirated material on the school's computers.
5. It is not permitted to change or delete files and settings on the computer or network.

What happens if the rules are not followed?

If you break the rules, you may be banned from the school's computers and network for a short or long period of time.
