Swedish for immigrants (SFI) is a basic course in the Swedish language. You will also learn about Swedish society.

The course is aimed at those who are not native speakers of Swedish. You can study SFI if you are registered in Växjö Municipality and have a full national ID number or if you are an EU citizen and reside in Växjö. You can register from the year you turn 16.

All courses are free.

Växjöloftet Adult Education allows you to choose where you wish to study. You can choose between the different schools approved by Växjö Municipality. You have every opportunity to find the school and form of study that suit you best. This allows you to combine your studies with work, a trainee program, or other education.

SFI offers three different courses of study.

- Study course 1. For those who cannot read and write in their native language or have only completed a few years of school.
Slow study pace.

- Study course 2. For those who have attended compulsory school or high school. Normal study pace.

- Study course 3. For those who have started academic education and have good study skills and the ability to work independently. Fast study pace.
